

## **Prof. Subrat Kumar Acharya**

Gastroenterologist and Hepatologist Prof. (Dr.) Subrat Kumar Acharya was born in Balasore in 1951. He obtained his M.D. (General Medicine) degree from Utkal University and D.M. degree in Gastroenterology from AIIMS, Delhi. He started his service career as Assistant Surgeon in Department of Health and FW, Government of Odisha and then as Lecture in Gastroenterology in SCB Medical College. He joined as Assistant Professor in AIIMS in the year 1986 and retired as Professor and Head of Gastroenterology department. He is working as Pro-Chancellor, KIIT University after retirement.

His illustrious teaching and research career spans over 38 years during which he has published nearly 227 high standard research papers in national and international journals besides contributing chapter to 27 books. He has to his credit 68 scientific reviews and invited editorials in different journals. He has also attended 60 international conferences and presented papers.

In recognition to his work he was awarded 'Padma Shree' by the Government of India in the year 2014. Other prestigious awards include J.C. Bose Fellowship, Samanta Chandra Sekhar award, National Academy of Sciences, Allahabad Fellowship, Indian Academy of Sciences, Bengaluru Fellowship, Mitra Olympus Endoscopy Award and PN Berry award of England.
